




In this final half-term, we will be consolidating our knowledge learnt over the year

so far as well as undertaking small projects which will provide pupils an opportunity to revisit many of the skills and curriculum content covered both in Year 6 and also the rest of Key Stage 2. The projects have been designed to explore maths in real life contexts, allowing children to see how important maths is in all aspects of their life. Finally we will also be focusing on mental maths skills and we will

be using MyMaths to embed maths at home too!

Quizzing

To link with out study of WW2, children will be creating tunnel books after looking at a range of WW2 Blitz Art and work/sculptures

by Henry Moore. We will use these images to tell a story and describe settings and scenes.

In French this half term, the children will be learning to express basic opinions on food and clothing and they will be learning to make basic food orders in a café.



This term in our computing lessons, we will be using Purple Mash to create picture based quizzes for young children. We will use the programme '2Quiz' to create a variety of quizzes, ending the unit by creating an, **Unit: 6.7** `Are you smarter than a 10-year-old' quiz for our parents and teachers!

History - We will be continuing to look at WW2 in more detail during this topic particularly focusing on The Battle of Britain and why this was a turning point in History and the end of the war including VE day celebrations. We also hope to visit our school Blast Shelter a small part of our local history!





PSHE (including RHE)

Our Jigsaw unit this term is: "Changing Me"

In this unit we will also be looking at: growing up, how bodies change during puberty for boys/girls, following the journey of a baby from conception to birth and discussing the transition to our new Secondary Schools. Science

This half-term the children will be learning about electricity. The children will begin to
