

Where? Class Dojo

- Based on our topic or story for the week

Maths Home Learning



Where: Class Dojo

- Used to consolidate the week of maths learning
- Ask your child to explain what they have learned or describe the activities they did
- Suggestions of a task/video link attached
- Does not need to be recorded and/or brought into school

Where: Class Dojo

- Links to taught sounds
- Support letter formation
- Keep an eye on your child!
- 5-10 minutes is long enough!

- Don't forget to read the physical book with your child too!




