PUPIL PARLIAMENT MEETING

MINUTES

28th March 2019

1. Actions from previous meeting:

- Reps have suggested that home learning books may be better than home learning folders – Mrs Morjaria will look into this
- There was a request for buddies to create more games at lunchtimes, particularly in the KS1 playground – Miss Patel and Mr Homan will look into this
- There was a request for a golf club – Mr Homan will find out how much interest there is
- The storage cupboards in some classrooms are very full as pupils are bringing large bags to school – could Y3 and Y4 have trays for their fruit pots so that there is more space in the cupboards?
- Could show and tell/golden time be introduced in KS2? Show and tell for key stage 2 pupils would need to be more focused on learning e.g. a special project that pupils have done at home that they would like to share. Golden time is not part of our school policy at the moment but we will review this.

2. Following up on pupil survey

- What does friendly atmosphere mean to you? What makes a classroom friendly? Respect in the classroom, cooperative and helpful, children working together, general positivity and celebrating successes, showing that we care for each other, thoughtful, looking out for each other, helping others when they are stuck.
- What can we/you do to make it feel more friendly? Brain breaks, honesty – owning up, celebrating others' achievements, positive mindset, 'fill your bucket' – paying positive compliments.
We discussed why this question may have had lower responses than we expected – perhaps pupils did not understand what the question was asking. Pupil Parliament agreed that overall we have a friendly atmosphere in our school and would benefit from a positive mindset – focusing on the positives.

- #### 3. Future meetings – Chair/Vice Chair/Secretary –
- We discussed the roles of the Chair and Vice Chair and Secretary in running future Pupil Parliament meetings and agreed to hold an election at our next meeting. ACTION: Year 6 Reps to consider which role they would be interested in being elected for and write a brief speech explaining why they would like to be elected.

- Sports in playgrounds – pupils have requested rotas similar to the football rota for different sports
- There was a suggestion to display words related to kindness as inspirational words around the school – Larissa and Dean will speak with Mrs Dhalla about this
- Tennis club was requested – Ali to speak with Mr Homan about this
- More equipment was requested for target boards in the KS2 playground – Aaron will speak with Miss A Patel
- There was a request for more lunchtime sports activities for girls – Shay will speak with Mr Ehui about this
- There was a request for Stanburn University to be reinstated
