



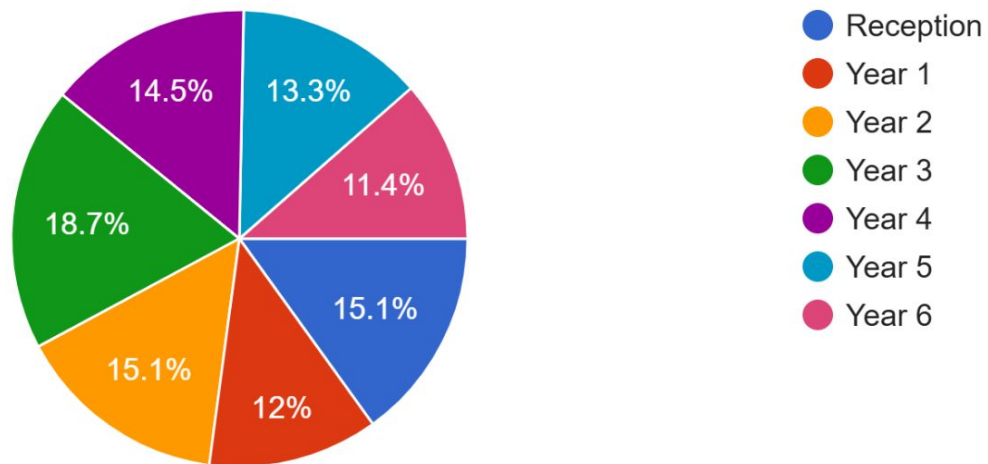

## Year Group

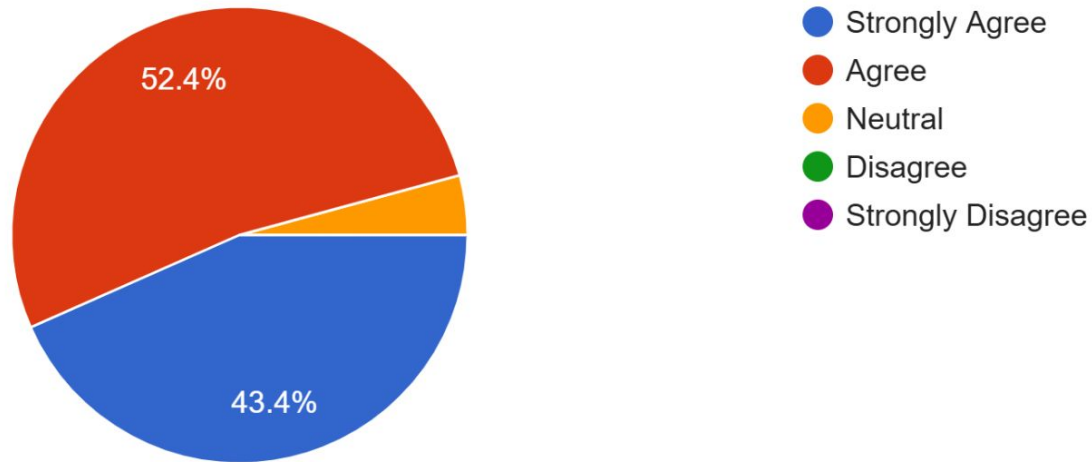

Quality of Education Stanburn Primary School provides a broad and balanced curriculum across all subjects, including the arts, humanities, and PE.

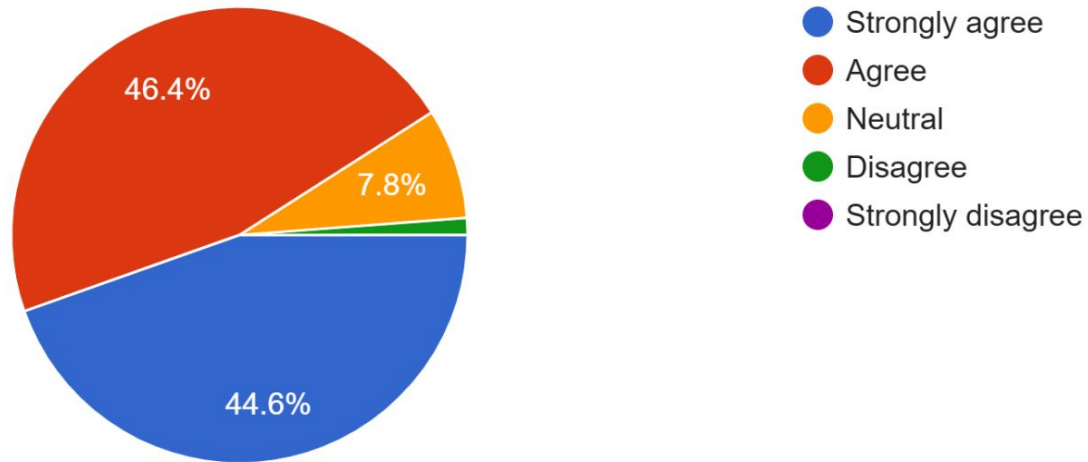

Quality of Education I feel informed about my child's progress, attainment and areas of improvement through reports and parents' meetings.

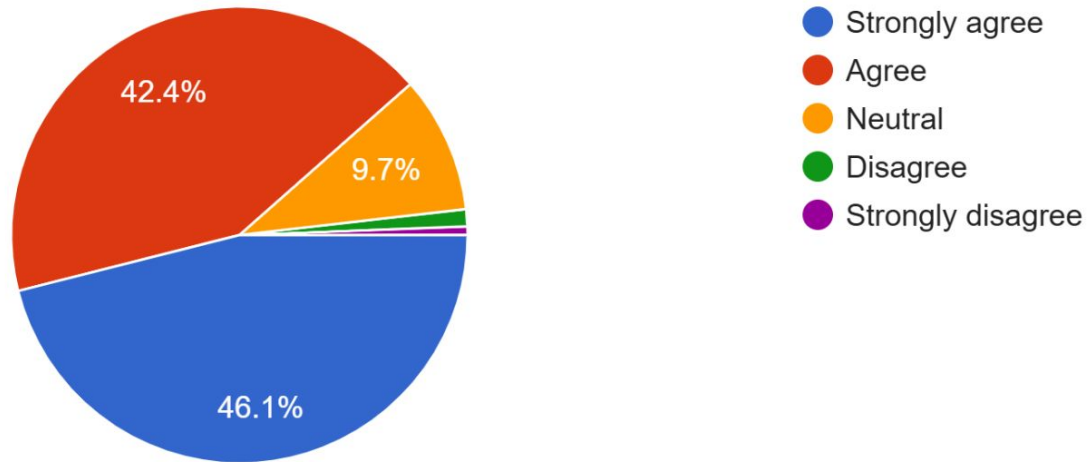

Behaviour and Attitudes Stanburn Primary School supports children to develop positive social skills and looks after pupil's emotional well-being.

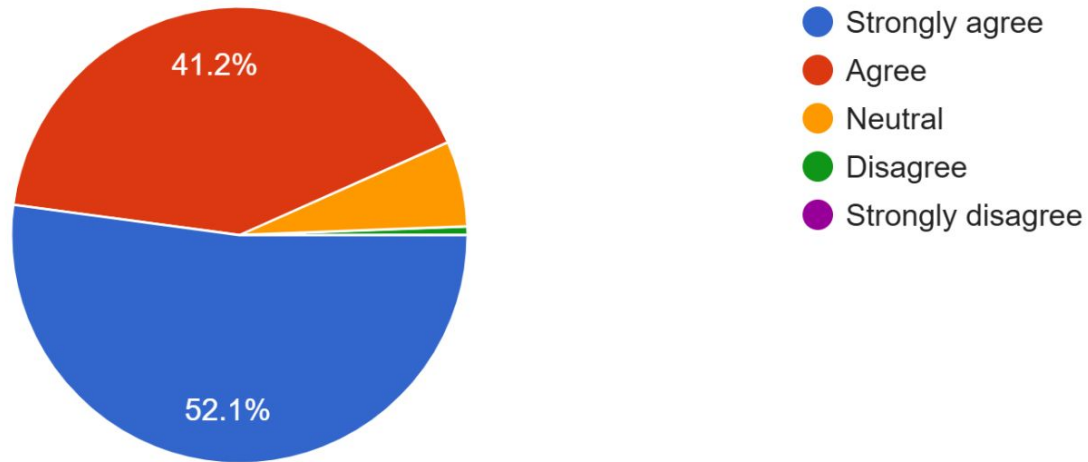

# Personal Development

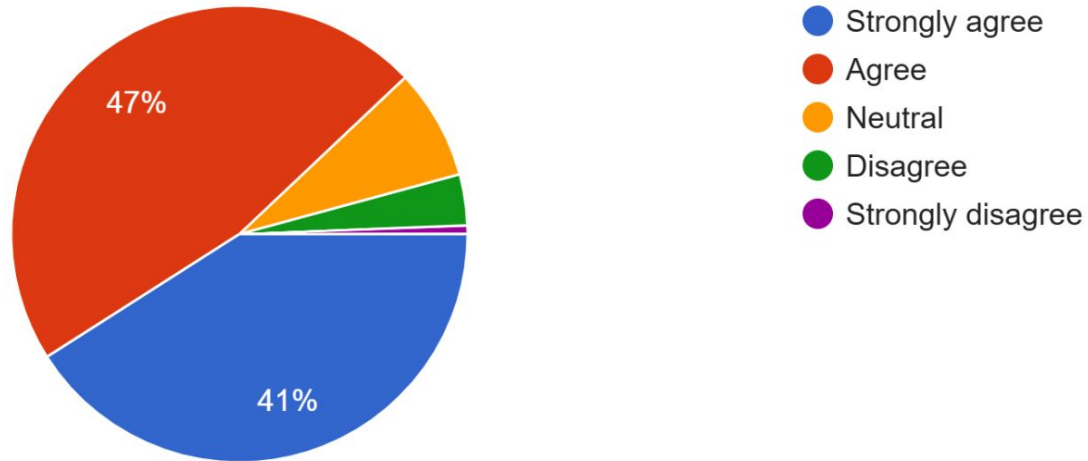
Personal Development Stanburn Primary School celebrates diversity and teaches children about different cultures, backgrounds, and beliefs.

## Lunches
